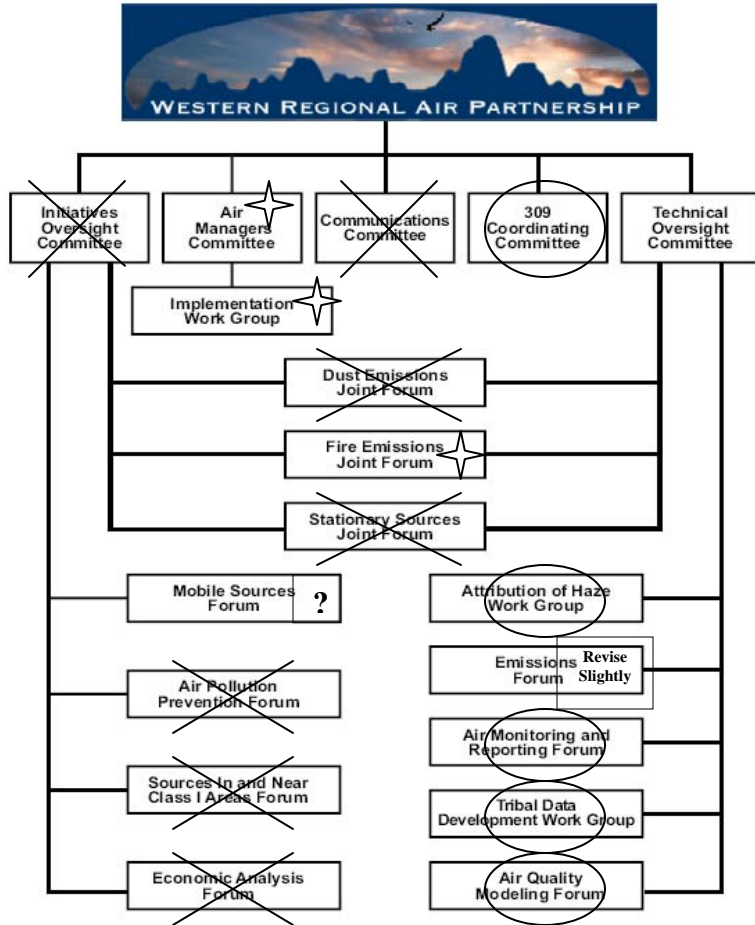
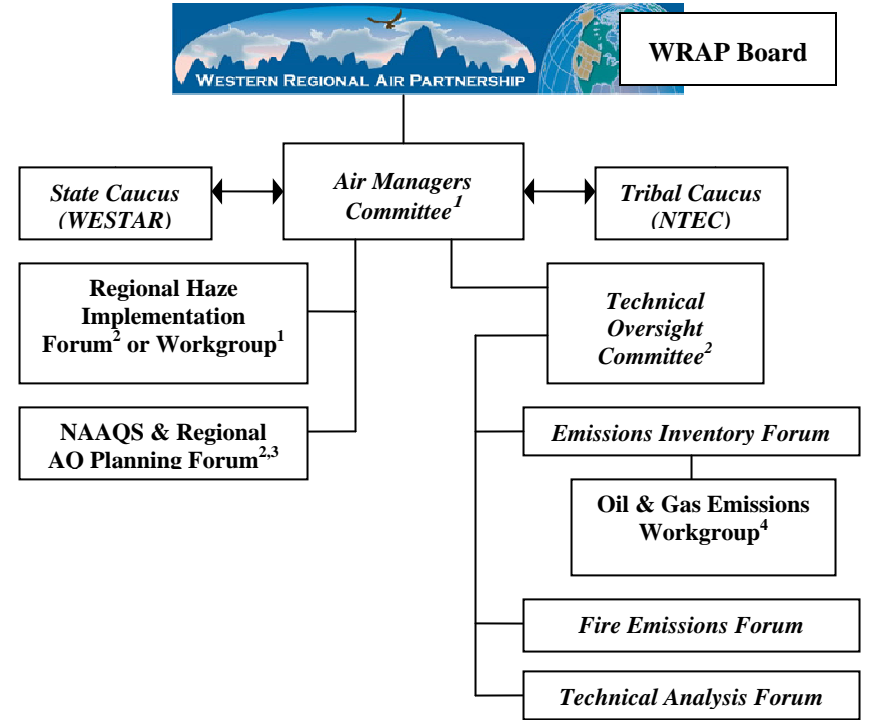


WRAP Organizational Chart circa 2005-08 + future status

¹ – AMC members will be air director/program manager-level representatives of WRAP member agencies with open meetings and calls. The AMC would coordinate the overall activities of WRAP as an executive body, meeting periodically to provide direction and advice to the working level of the WRAP organization.

² – TOC and all Forums would be stakeholder-based (balanced and specified number of members from states, tribes, federal agencies, industry, and environmental groups), with 2 Co-Chairs from a state, a tribe, and/or a federal agency. If the Regional Haze Implementation “unit” on the chart is determined to be only WRAP members, then it would be a Workgroup.

³ - “The purpose of the WRAP is to identify regional or common air management issues, develop and implement strategies to address these issues, and formulate and advance western regional policy positions on air quality.” (WRAP Charter - <http://www.wrapair.org/WRAP/charter/charter.html>). This Forum will be stakeholder-based to exchange information and determine the need for regional coordination, programs, policies, and activities related to these topics.

⁴ – O&G Emissions Workgroup would be stakeholder-based (open to interested staff from states, tribes, feds, industry, and environmental groups), with 2 Co-Chairs (1 state and 1 federal agency). The activities of this Workgroup would be coordinated by the Emissions Inventory Forum.
