12/18/00 Nominee Status

The "postcard" (reminder.wpd) was sent out on 12/11/00 to 120 people (31 of which had not received the flyer previously) by Deb Kinsley at WGA. In addition, after receiving full mailing information, I sent out postcards and flyers to 9 people.

New Nomination Deadline is Wednesday, 12/20/00.

The updated nominations received as of 12/15/00 PM (NBTT nomination form12_15.wpd) stands at 22 for Senior Staff Wkshp, 10 for Policy Maker Wkshp, and 7 for both wkshps. We still have a way to go before we reach 75 for the 1st workshop and 20 policy/20 staff for the 2nd workshop.

12/21/00 Nominee Status

The New Nomination Deadline was Yesterday Wednesday, 12/20/00. Deb Kinsley at WGA sent me an update this AM as they don't receive their mail until between 2 - 5 pm.

The updated nominations received as of 12/21/00 AM (NBTT nomination form12_21.wpd or NBTT nomination form12_21.doc) stands at 29 for Senior Staff Wkshp, 19 for Policy Maker Wkshp, and 9 for both wkshps.

If we accept as participants all who responded to the invitation that will give us **38 for the January workshop and 28 for the March Workshop**. The breakdown on representation is as follows SS Wkshp (12 State Reg, 2 State Forest, 1 Env, 2 Ag, 6 USFS, 3 NPS, 2 Reg. Planning, 1 Local Reg, 3 Industry, 2 Tribal, 2 BLM, 1 Local Fire Dept, 1 FWS) and PM Wkshp (7 State Reg, 2 State Forest, 1 Env, 4 Ag, 5 USFS, 1 NPS, 1 Reg Planning, 3 Tribal, 3 Academic, 1 FWS).

We need to decide how to proceed from here: Do we accept everyone who sent in a nomination?, What do we do about additional nominations received after the deadline 12/20/00?, Do we need to solicit representation from other sectors? (How & Who?), etc.
