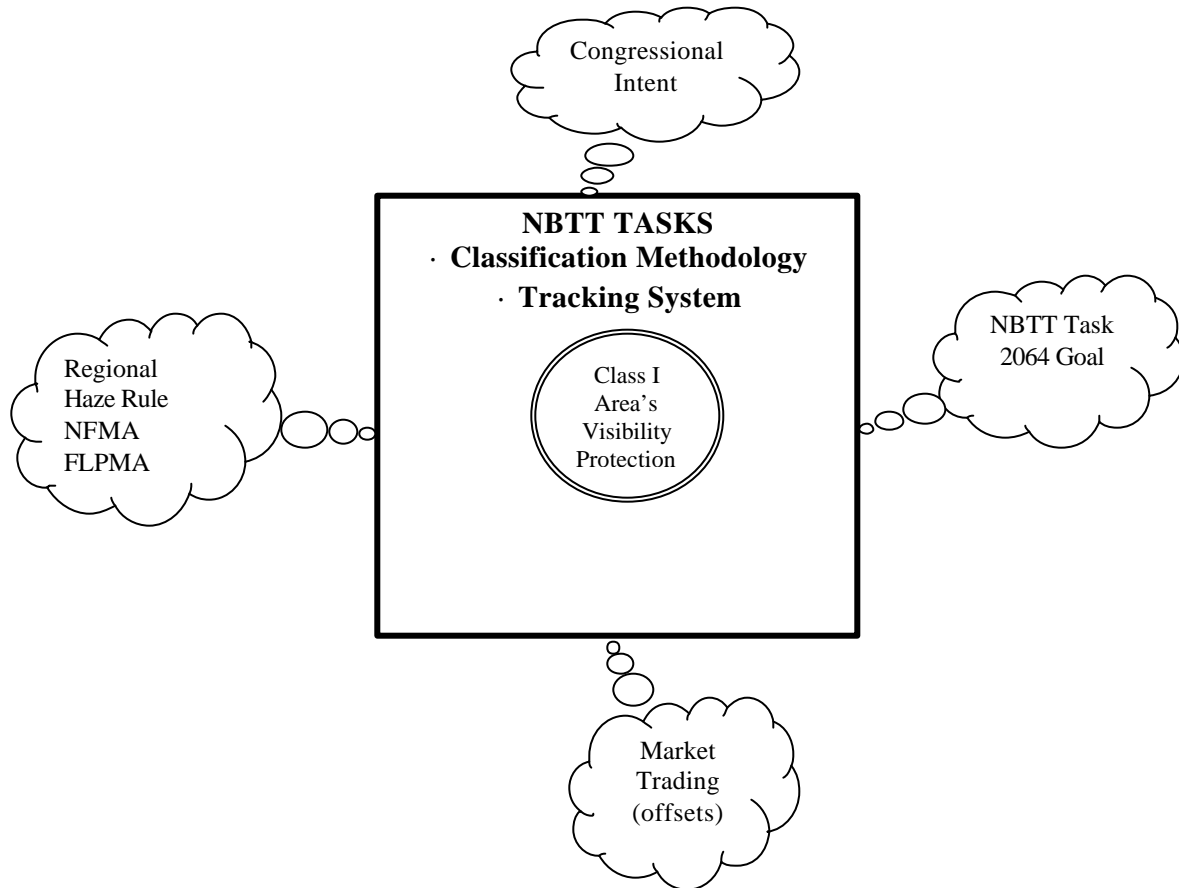


The NBTT needs to stay focused on the tasks at hand and stay inside the box.



1. AGREE ON WHAT WE (THE NBTT) ARE HERE TO ACCOMPLISH

- maximize clean air
- maximize ecosystem function/health
- compromise
 - political reality – clean air is protected by regulation and is “in” with the general public
 - physical reality – fire will happen one way or the other

2. NEED TO GET PEOPLE THINKING BEYOND THEIR BIAS (CORE BELIEFS) ((as they can))

- Recognize the bias/core beliefs exist
- Find areas of agreement
- Talk about trust (or lack of trust)
- Understand and acknowledge each other’s mission

3. IF NBTT DOESN’T DO THE CLASSIFICATIONS WHO WILL?

- EPA
- Congress
- Courts

BASIC CONCLUSIONS -----

- NBTT needs to take some foundations forward to future NBTT meetings and the workshops.
