# SIP Planning Status

## (40,000 ft)

- States are writing their SIPs
  - Most WRAP work is complete
  - Activity shifted to state use of WRAP work products
  - Completion schedules vary
    - 8-10 states adopt first half 2008
    - 5 -7 states adopt second half 2008 or later
- BART determinations are underway
  - Much longer than anticipated
    - Late start due to court decisions and revised EPA BART rule
    - Engineering analyses taking longer than expected

# Remaining Issues (Cont.)

- Reasonable Progress Goals (308)
  - In nearly all Class I Areas, RPG O<sub>3</sub>URG for 20% worst-case days
  - Contributing sources are numerous and variable
  - Controllable – stationary Point, Area, Mobile, some fire, some dust
    - SO<sub>2</sub> reductions already made or projected through BART and other controls (Success!)
    - NO<sub>x</sub> controls not fully identified for all sources
  - Not Controllable – wildfire, windblown dust, External (Asia, Canada, Mexico)

# Reasonable Progress Goals

- Push to look at other sources for RPG, LTS
- States, IWG are working to identify additional sources to evaluate
- Detailed evaluation probably won't occur this planning cycle for very many sources

# Reasonable Progress Goals

- States will look at additional sources, include evaluations at five-year review
  - Include review processes in Long-term strategies
- IWG developing consistent approach to RPG requirement, including consideration of statutory factors

# Remaining Issues (Cont.)

- Consultation
  - State-to-state where cross border impacts are identified
  - FLM 60 day notice, response to FLM comments
  - Ongoing consultation with FLM
- IWG developing consistent language, documentation of WRAP consultation
