

## **\*DRAFT\*Master Key for Road Map, Relationship Table, and Matrix**

**Purpose:** This key pertains to all of the 308 Regional Haze SIP/TIP guides: the Development Road Map, the Relationship Table, and the Resource Matrix. The Road Map is a process guide to the rule requirements. Some of the processes occur at the same time, while others loop back to be re-evaluated. The Relationship Table lists WRAP work products detailed within the WRAP Work Plan. The Resource Matrix outlines general rule components as a skeletal guide to the actual SIP/TIP structure. All three guides are cross-referenced and dynamic. An eventual fourth guide – a table of contents for the Technical Support Document - will allow the SIP/TIP writer to visualize how the technical data relates to the SIP/TIP text.
