

Summary for July 28, 2008 Oil & Gas Workgroup Call

Call Summary:

Although we weren't able to keep track of all the names, there were upwards to 40+ participants call in. On the call, Environ's Amnon Bar-Ilan went through a PDF of his presentation on the history of O&G Emission Inventory efforts in the WRAP Region and the reasons for undertaking a third round of inventory revisions for the major producing basins currently operating in the Intermountain West. He covered the Temporal, Geographic, Pollutant and Source Categories Scope of the Phase III effort, and described in somewhat general terms, the methodology being used to compile the 2006 Baseline Inventory, as well as the Mid-Term (2012) and Far Future Year (2018) Projection Inventories target by this Phase III effort. And he went over the project schedule, currently aiming for completion of all basin inventories and compilation in a Final Report about the middle of 2009.

During the call, Stakeholders raised three main issues which included:

- 1) Mobile Source Emissions incident to O&G Field Operations (ie/ employee access, delivery/service vehicles)
- 2) Methodology to be used for Far Future Year (2018) Projections
- 3) Non-Criteria Hazardous & Other Air Pollutants incident to O&G Field Operations

Although not all of these issues are within the Scope of the Phase III effort, the WRAP will try to engage its membership to address these questions in some manner more fully in the future.
