

Forums' Status Report for TOC – July 11, 2003

Air Quality Modeling

- Activities - Completed §309 modeling for TSD, modeling results writeup to be complete for final draft TSD publication on July 15th, finally able to start on new projects for 2003 workplan, QA/QC/protocol projects top priority for next 2-3 months, Co-Chairs have identified meeting date of October 8-9 in Riverside to review drafts of protocols and new modeling tools, larger workshop planned in January 2004 to roll out new tools/protocols.
- Budget – discussed with Co-Chairs, level funding of \$600k for RMC, additional ~\$200k for Alaska work – Tom to write up.

Ambient Monitoring & Reporting

- Activities – First group of draft products from Causes of Haze (CofH) project to be presented and discussed at a yet unscheduled Forum meeting later this Summer, this meeting will need to focus on aligning products and timeline to TOC Source Apportionment schedule.
- Budget – Same as proposed for 2004 last year, carryforward from 2003 CofH, new 2004 \$ for CofH are ~\$225k, and ~\$50k for VIEWS – Tom to write up.

Dust Emissions

- Activities – Lee Gribovicz has solicited, interviewed, and proposed 2 Co-Chairs for this Forum, to replace Mark Scruggs. They are Carrie MacDougall, Deputy Director of the Clark County (Las Vegas), NV air agency, and Duane Ono, Deputy Director of the Great Basin Unified APCD in Bishop (Owens Lake), CA. Both Duane and Carrie have a wealth of experience with dust emissions. They are contacting potential Forum members.
- Budget – Carrie and Duane are preparing a draft budget for the Planning Team meeting.

Emissions

- Activities – Forum meeting July 1-2. Reviewed draft final Emissions Data Management System “Needs Assessment” report, updates on TEISS and windblown dust projects, and prepared 2004 budget proposal.
- Budget – Proposal to carryforward ~\$250k, and new 2004 \$ of ~\$ 700k, Dennis and Alice are preparing

Fire Emissions

- Activities – Forum meeting June 3-4. Working to complete existing 309 projects, put out “fires” on 309 EIs, and begin work on 2002 Fire EIs, presentation on fire activity tracking tools, discussed how to get modeling-related technical analyses completed, possible using RMC subcontract.
- Budget – Ron and Pete are preparing

- Activities – Workgroup meeting April 28, reviewed ITEP contract activities, progress on TEISS, decision to add functions to TEISS, final software after testing by December 2003.
